

## Media Bias

To the media,

We the people, the citizens of the United States of America, have grown tired of the way the media has been distorting the truth about illegal immigrants. It seems to us, that you are unable to differentiate between the peoples of North America. So, in this letter I will be speaking of Mexicans, legal and illegal, and United States citizens so there will be no mistake in who I am talking about.

There are several issues that we the people feel are critical, and that need to be addressed. I would like to point these out, and ask you the question, Why are you not reporting on these as being illegal? Why do you uphold these violations of our laws? You are supposed to report the truth, yet you continually turn your heads from the truth, and only print halve truths. I will state our case point by point.

Point number 1:

Illegal immigration; Under [Title 8 Section 1325](#) of the U.S. Code, "Improper Entry by Alien," any citizen of any country other than the United States who:

- Enters or attempts to enter the United States at any time or place other than as designated by immigration officers; or
- Eludes examination or inspection by immigration officers; or
- Attempts to enter or obtains entry to the United States by a willfully false or misleading representation or the willful concealment of a material fact;

has committed a federal crime.

Violations are punishable by criminal fines and imprisonment for up to six months. Repeat offenses can bring up to two years in prison. Additional civil fines may be imposed at the discretion of immigration judges, but civil fines do not negate the criminal sanctions or nature of the offense.

Point number 2:

Sanctuary cities; For example, the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigration Responsibility Act of 1996 (IIRIRA) states the following without equivocation:

Notwithstanding any other provision of Federal, State, or local law, a Federal, State, or local government entity or official may not prohibit or in any way restrict any government entity or official from sending to or receiving from the Immigration and Naturalization Service information regarding the citizenship or immigration status, lawful or unlawful, of any individual.

The following is an overview of federal law on **hiring and harboring illegal aliens**. It is not a substitute for professional legal counsel in specific situations.

Summary

A person (including a group of persons, business, organization or local government) commits a federal felony when he:  
\* assists an alien whom he should reasonably know is illegally in the U.S. or who lacks employment authorization, by transporting, sheltering, or assisting him to obtain employment,

\* encourages that alien to remain in the U.S., by referring him to an employer, by acting as employer or agent for an employer in any way, or

\* knowingly assists illegal aliens due to personal convictions.

Penalties upon conviction include criminal fines, imprisonment, and forfeiture of vehicles and real property used to commit the crime.

Any city or person who gives sanctuary to an illegal immigrant is in violation of federal law, and has committed a felony.

Point number 3:

Disrespect and abuse of the American Flag; [TITLE 4 > CHAPTER 1 >](#)

§ 7. Position and manner of display

(f) When flags of States, cities, or localities, or pennants of societies are flown on the same halyard with the flag of the United States, the latter should always be at the peak. When the flags are flown from adjacent staffs, the flag of the United States should be hoisted first and lowered last. No such flag or pennant may be placed above the flag of the United States or to the United States flag's right.

(g) When flags of two or more nations are displayed, they are to be flown from separate staffs of the same height. The flags should be of approximately equal size. International usage forbids the display of the flag of one nation above that of another nation in time of peace.

§ 8. Respect for flag

No disrespect should be shown to the flag of the United States of America; the flag should not be dipped to any person or thing. Regimental colors, State flags, and organization or institutional flags are to be dipped as a mark of honor.

(a) The flag should never be displayed with the union down, except as a signal of dire distress in instances of extreme danger to life or property
